### Slaughter Pig Marketing Summary

<b>This week</b>
A change in the month did little to change the fortunes of the trade on Friday as an increase in supply was met with steady demand. Eastern counties processors were particularly difficult. Both Tulip and Woodheads took a penny out of their contract prices. The fresh pork trade was better to deal with as their demand picked up after the Bank holiday. Sow prices stood on as continental prices came under pressure. European prices reversed sharply with Belgium and Spain suffering the biggest falls. Sterling strengthened however, with the Euro valued at 83.32p.

### Weaner Marketing Summary

<b>w/c 29/08/10</b>
Supply was again good but fatteners were wary and this resulted in generally lower bids. Increased quotes for finishing rations are having a dampening affect on demand. The AHDB 30kg average was virtually unchanged at £47.39.
